PROCLAMATION (Amended to Include Executive Order 23-172)

I, Russell C. Weigel, III, as Commissioner of the Office of Financial Regulation, by the power vested in me through Section 655.90, Florida Statutes, do hereby acknowledge Office of the Governor, Executive Order Numbers 23-171 and 23-172, which describe emergency conditions potentially caused by Invest 93L, currently known as Tropical Storm Idalia, and therefore authorize state, national, and federally chartered financial institutions located in the following counties: Alachua, Baker, Bay, Bradford, Calhoun, Charlotte, Citrus, Clay, Collier, Columbia, DeSoto, Dixie, Duval, Flagler, Franklin, Gadsden, Gilchrist, Gulf, Hamilton, Hardee, Hernando, Hillsborough, Jefferson, Lafayette, Lake, Lee, Leon, Levy, Liberty, Madison, Manatee, Marion, Nassau, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, Putnam, Sarasota, Seminole, St. Johns, Sumter, Suwannee, Taylor, Union, Volusia, and Wakulla; to close or remain closed until the officers of such institutions advise me that the emergency conditions no longer exist.
